Dear Valued Guests of the Fulton Theatre:

Since the emergence of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Fulton Theatre has been committed to the health and safety of our patrons, guests, artists and staff. With wellbeing as a top priority, the Fulton is announcing a change to face covering policy.

The masking requirement has been extended through the run of Rodgers & Hammerstein's Cinderella. The Fulton Theatre requires that face masks be worn by all audience members while attending a performance in any of our series. Masks are required except when eating or drinking in our lobbies and theatres. We will now be allowing food and drink into the theatre. Securely fitting masks must cover the nose and mouth, and have no valves; scarves and neck gaiters are not acceptable.

The leadership of the Fulton Theatre will continue to monitor guidance issued by the CDC and state and local health officials, and will update COVID protocols as circumstances allow.


